

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
## Torah \( \neq \text{Law} \)

Torah = Teaching / Instruction




### A Look at the Roots

#### God's Righteousness



There are several Hebrew words that can be translated sin. One of those words, hata (tyi) means, "to miss the mark."

#### God's Righteousness



The Hebrew word Torah comes from the root yara (yrh) which means,
"hitting the mark."
Thus, Torah means "God's teaching / instruction that hits the mark."






## A heavenly system based on "7" - representing wholeness and completion!

- The 7<sup>th</sup> Day (Shabbat)
- The 7<sup>th</sup> Month (Tishri)
- The 7<sup>th</sup> Year (Sh'mittah)
- 7 sevens of years = 49 (Jubilee or Yovel)
- 70 weeks prophecy (Daniel 9:24-27 70 x 7 years = 490 years)
- 7 seals, 7 trumpets, 7 bowls (Revelation)


