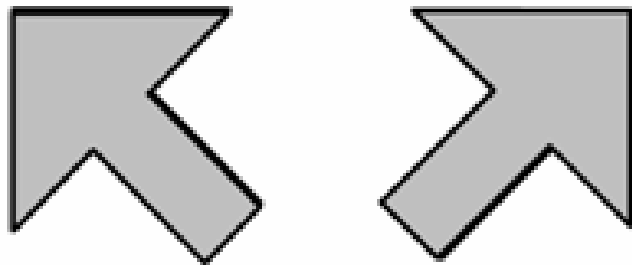

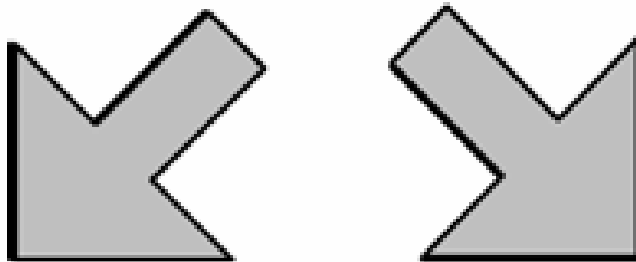

God's Righteousness

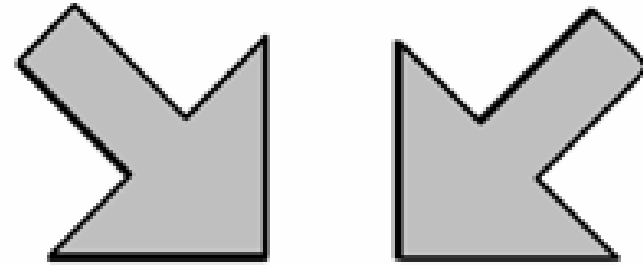

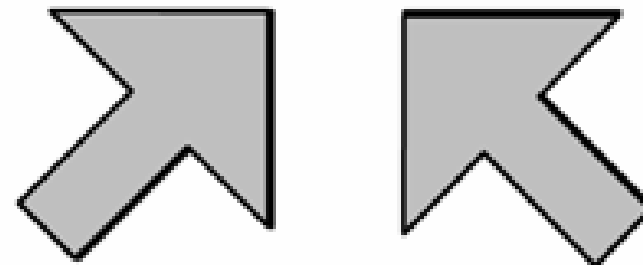


There are several Hebrew words that can be translated sin.

The Hebrew word Torah comes from the root vara (vrh) which means, "hitting the mark."
 Thus, Torah means "God's teaching / instruction that hits the mark."

A heavenly system based on "7" - representing wholeness and completion!























- The 7th Day (Shabbat)
